



Mahalo for your interest in auditioning for *Man of La Mancha*! After a six-year hiatus, we are thrilled to be back at the MACC with another large-scale musical in Castle Theater. *Man of La Mancha* will be directed by David C. Johnston with music direction by John Rowehl.

How do I Sign up for Auditions?

Two easy steps!

- 1. Complete this **Audition Form**.
- 2. Sign-up for a ten-minute audition slot here.

How do I Prepare for Auditions?

- Read this packet!
- Prepare 16 bars of a song that best demonstrates your range.
- Bring sheet music (preferred) or electronic track. Accompanist will be provided.
- If you have not auditioned for David Johnston in the past, please also prepare a short monologue (1-2 minutes).

Auditions will be held in MAPA's Living Room, 2050 Main Street, 3rd floor, Wailuku. The Wailuku parking garage is now open, and parking is free (2 hour maximum). Entrance is from Church Street between (Main and Vineyard).

Why did MAPA choose Man of La Mancha?

In choosing a show, one of the main criteria Artistic Director David C. Johnston uses is the relevance of the show's theme to the issues our community is currently facing. Johnston asks, "Will this show spark the kinds of conversations our community is interested in right now?"

Johnston's artistic philosophy is based on the belief that theatre is more than entertainment: theatre grounds us in our humanity. Reaching across the boundaries that divide us, theatre develops empathy and reconnects us to one another, renewing our sense of community. Theatre serves as an antidote to the uncertainties and anxieties of these times, offering cathartic messages of compassion and solace and inspiring us to imagine a new future in a better world.

With its powerful message about the triumph of hope over despair and the indomitability of the human spirit, *Man of La Mancha* offers profound opportunities for healing. As the Maui community struggles to navigate our collective heartbreak, this emotional story inspires us to find light even in the darkest of times. Through his irrepressible idealism and imagination, Don Quixote shows us how to muster the courage to dream our impossible dream and to fight for what's right.

In addition to the production, we are planning a series of community engagement events designed to deepen audience members' experiences with the show's message. We'll share more info in the coming months...
